OF ASSUMING OFFICE

1. Gazetting, and announcing that the 2 duty-free barrels between now and Christmas from families abroad have been put into effect
2. Commencement of payment of \$400.00 per month to old age pensioners.
3. Repealing amendment to National Parks Act
4. Reorganization of Government Information Service (GIS)
5. Reorganization of the Electoral Office
6. Establishing a body to deal with the Pension Disqualification Act
7. Renaming international airport after Maurice Bishop. Specially planned activity with Nadia Bishop's involvement. Renaming Carriacou airport after Herbert Blaize
8. Implementation of free school books programme
9. Amending trade union law which seeks to jail workers for strike action
10. Abolishing the National Reconstruction Levy Act
11. Granting George Grants application for a radio licence
12. Appointment of a forensic accountant to trace millions of dollars stashed away in foreign banks by Keith Mitchell, Gregory Bowen et al
13. TB issue in jail. Getting comprehensive testing of prisoners and officers
14. Setup Prison Review Board
15. Examine the possibility of sending a 400 x 400 relay team to the Beijing Olympics
16. Put system in place to initiate reconstruction of the House of Parliament and the Prime Minister's residence
17. Start the process of local government in Carriacou
18. Setup Advisory Councils on:
  - a. Economy in general(subcommittees on Agriculture, Tourism. Others to follow);
  - b. Health care delivery;
  - c. Education enhancement/expansion;
